ABOUT US

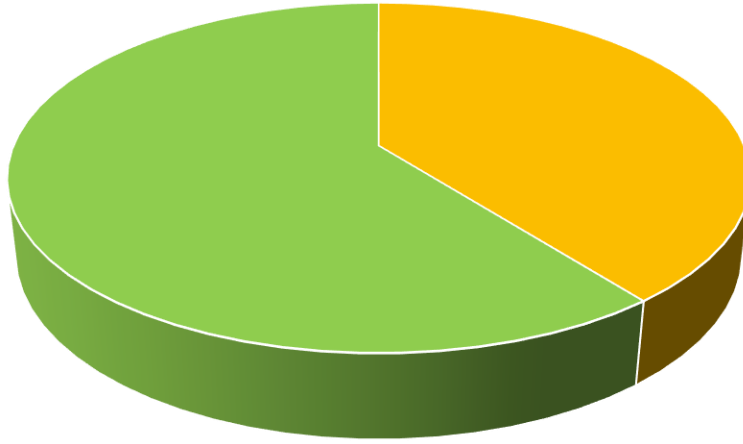
The Significance of One is a non-profit organization that operates using unpaid volunteers in the United States of America. These volunteers oversee school sponsorship programs in Haiti. The volunteers also raise funds for various other ministry opportunities to support and advance the well being of the Haitian people.



Currently, the Significance of One (SoO) continues to provide the sponsorship needed to operate the two existing schools in Canaan (150 students) and Bercy (90 students). SoO has recently added a new school to the program, the Agape School in Duclos, with twenty-one kindergarten aged students.

2021 allowed SoO, through volunteer efforts in the US, to provide thousands of prepackaged meals to be shipped from the US to Haiti to provide food for not only the students nutritional needs, but also to provide for the most at risk within the school communities.

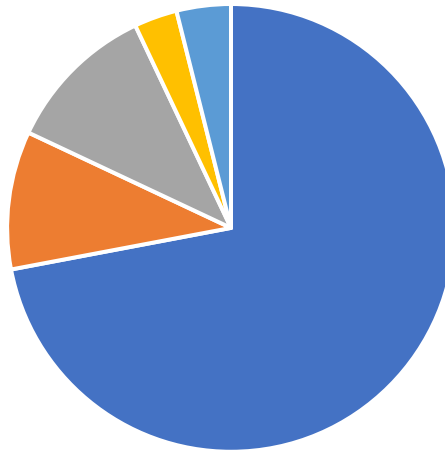
Despite the turmoil that the citizens in the country are experiencing, SoO and our partners have been able to continue to expand the schools and increase enrollment, to provide medical care to those in need, and support families of the paid workers that are doing the work to build and run the schools (construction laborers, teachers, support staff, etc.) as well as the licensed medical practitioners and community staff that run the medical clinics.






2021 Overall Giving

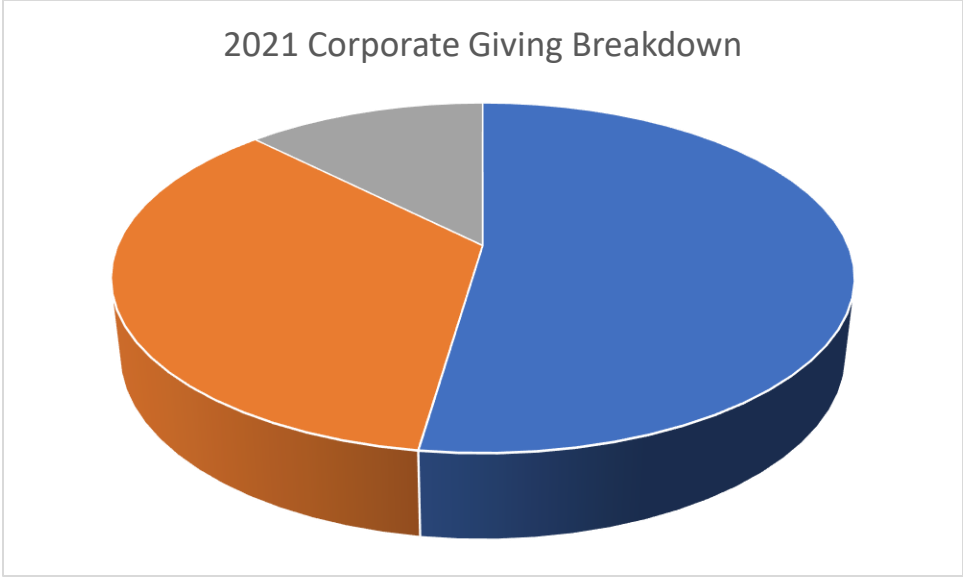

Summary:

2021 has been a very challenging year for The Significance of One and those that we support in the country of Haiti. The level of political unrest in the country has continued to increase making it harder to operate the schools and provide for the needs of the people.

Covid-19 also made it very difficult to operate inside the country, but SoO and our partners have been able to adjust how the schools meet and where the schools meet to keep the kids engaged with their school work and less focused on the turmoil that surrounds them.

SoO was also able to provide over \$40K to help rebuild housing the south section of Haiti that was directly affect by the earth quake they experienced.

SoO has been able to provide money for emergency medical care to Haitian citizens that did not have the means to secure treatment otherwise.

SoO will continue to support the churches, schools and those on the ground that make everything work, despite the hardships that they face daily. 2022 will present its own challenges and SoO and our team will face them head-on in order to provide the resources the citizens need to survive.
